SUBJECT: Euthanasia of Rodents (Lethobarb). (June 2015)

POLICY:

PRECAUTIONS: Gloves, eye protection, mask, long-sleeved gown, closed in shoes.

EQUIPMENT: 26g needle
2ml syringe
Lethobarb (15mg/100g)

PROCEDURE:

1. Restrain animal.
2. Administer Lethobarb as I/P injection.
3. Monitor vital signs to ensure that animal is dead.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Intra-hepatic injection of Lethobarb will induce a more rapid anaesthesia and death.
